

Step One

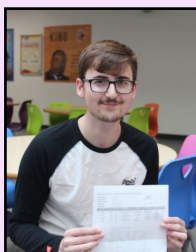

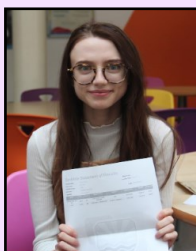
